Research Areas: ASSISTID Fellowship programmes will include, but are not limited to: Applied Behaviour Analysis and Autism, Augmentative and alternative communication, Assistive Technologies and Assisted living, Innovative learning, Ethics and rehabilitation, Intellectual disability policy and law, Multimedia development, Rehabilitation and counselling in employment for intellectual disability.
